## A NOTE TO DLI PARTICIPANTS:

Welcome back! We're absolutely delighted to continue our journey with the Doral Leadership Institute Community for the 2025-2026 academic year. As your close partner, Doral College is here to support you every step of the way. Our comprehensive course options are designed with your needs in mind, grounded in the latest best practices to help you thrive at every stage of your career.

To ensure you have the best possible experience with us, please keep the following guidelines in mind:

### **1. Do I need to apply to Doral College to take courses?**

Yes. First-time participants must apply for admission to Doral College in addition to registering for courses on Frontline. Apply at <https://doral.edu/apply>.

### **2. What is the difference between Frontline and Doral College's systems?**

Frontline is a separate platform used by DLI to track professional learning records. Selecting a course on Frontline starts the registration process, but does not enroll you in the course. Doral College manually completes enrollments after the Frontline registration period ends.

### **3. How do I register for courses on Frontline?**

As a DLI participant, you will want to sign up for courses via Frontline, which can be accessed through your work Colegia account by adding the DLI app. Once in Frontline, search for the DLI Activity Catalog, where you will find the listed courses. For further assistance with Frontline registration, please contact your school's professional learning liaison.

### **4. Where can I find DLI policies and procedures?**

Participants should review the DLI Policies and Procedures before registering. These are available at <https://doral.edu/dli>.

### **5. How do I drop a course after the Frontline registration period closes?**

Email your drop request to the DC Student Affairs Help Desk at [studentaffairs@doral.edu](mailto:studentaffairs@doral.edu) by the published deadlines, as outlined in the DLI Policies and Procedures.

### **6. Are Zoom sessions required?**

Beginning Fall 2025, for any course that is part of the BSED or EPI programs, a mandatory Zoom session will be held during the first week of each term. Courses affected will be marked under the column "First Week Zoom Required." This is a requirement for all students enrolled in these courses, regardless of whether they are degree-seeking. Any student who fails to attend the session will be reported as a "No Show" and will be dropped accordingly.

### **7. How does Doral College award credit for DLI courses?**

Doral College awards academic credit (not Master Plan Points). For recertification, one college credit = 20 Master Plan Points (MPPs). Credit earned will appear on your college transcript, not in Frontline.

### **8. What other programs does Doral College offer?**

In addition to professional learning, Doral College offers:

- Associate's and bachelor's degrees
- A newly launched Master of Education in Educational Leadership
