## Summary

---

This report details the results of the 2024 Student Importance and Satisfaction Survey. This survey is administered mid-spring annually to all students enrolled in that term and serves as an important measure of student satisfaction. The survey includes a number of the College’s Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) and is evaluated as part of the College’s strategic planning process. This year there were 3,838 responses. The number of responses is significantly higher than the 2, 275 responses in 2023.

## Methodology

---

This year, the College administered the survey that was in 2022 and added two (2) questions, for an overall 14 questions, with some questions having multiple categories. There were also optional open-ended questions to solicit additional feedback. When calculating the responses, the number of responses that were “neither agree or disagree” were subtracted from the total number of responses to reflect a more valid percentage of the student experience.

Doral College serves five distinct student demographics:

1. AA – Non-Dual Enrollment
2. BSED
3. Dual Enrollment
4. Non-Degree Lower Level
5. Non-Degree Upper Level

To better assess and analyze how Doral College is serving each demographic, the report is divided into a section for each demographic. A comparison of the demographic responses is provided at the end of the report. This is the second time this change has been implemented with the assumption that the data will be more relevant. All students were surveyed using the same questions. However, some of the questions were not administered to all groups.

The questions were as follows:

Q1. How well do your Doral College instructors teach?

Q2. How often did your Doral College instructor(s) respond to email within 48 hours?

Q3. If dual enrollment, how satisfied are you with the Doral College course offerings?

- a. Variety of face-to-face / hybrid courses offered
- b. Number of face-to-face / hybrid courses offered
- c. Variety of online courses offered
- d. Number of online courses offered

Q4. Did you achieve, or will you have achieved upon completing your studies, the goals you had when you started this course or program?

Q5. How satisfied are you with the following processes?

- a. The admissions process

- b. The registration process

Q6. Indicate your satisfaction with the following at Doral College

- a. Use of Canvas
- b. Helpfulness of the college web page
- c. Helpfulness of the help desks (support, student affairs @ doral.edu)
- d. Learning resources (i.e. JSTOR, Gale)?

Q7. All things considered, were you satisfied with your studies with us?

Q8. Would you recommend these studies to a friend?

Q9. What challenges, if any, did/do you face in completing your Doral College coursework? Select all that apply.

As previously noted, a shorter survey is more in line with current practices and more likely to achieve a higher response rate.

The survey was administered via Collegia, the student single sign on to the systems, to the students who remained enrolled beyond the drop deadlines. 3,838 students completed the survey.

## AA – Non Dual Enrollment

---

The results reported below are from the 55 responses. Of those 55 responses, two respondents had not started classes yet. Therefore, the percentages are calculated based on 53 responses.

Q1. 70% reported that Doral College instructors taught “very well” or “extremely well”.

Q2. 78% reported that instructors responded to email within 48 hours. It should be noted that 24% had never attempted to email the instructor. Those responses were not included in the total number of responses.

Q3. The question was not administered to this demographic as it only applies to Dual Enrollment students.

Q4. 96% of the respondents stated that their course / program goals were achieved.

Q5. 81% reported satisfaction with the admissions process and 88% reported satisfaction with the registration process. As these two processes are the first interactions a student has with the College, the percentages are positive.

Q6. 96% reported satisfaction with the use of Canvas, 84% reported satisfaction with the Helpfulness of the webpage, 90% reported satisfaction with the help desks, 83% reported satisfaction with the learning resources. Overall, this demographic of students is highly satisfied with resources Doral College has put into place to foster student success.

Q7. 96% reported satisfaction with their studies. Once again, the high percentage is one metric to demonstrate Doral College's mission of "...delivering dynamic educational experiences by blending traditional and online learning, supportive partnerships, and technology to empower highly motivated and dedicated students to overcome conventional barriers."

Q8. 95% would recommend Doral College studies to a friend

Q9. The purpose of this question is to determine what specific barriers are in place for this demographic. 26% reported they were challenged by the difficulty of the material, 60% reported they were challenged by lack of time or too many responsibilities, 13% reported they were challenged by lack of wi-fi / computer access.

Q10. 51% reported at least one parent earned a four year degree. This data can be used by Doral College to create tools and programs to successfully guide students through the process of completing their program.

Q11. 31% reported interest in a BBA program.

Q12. 29% reported interest in a BAS concentrating in legal studies, criminal justice, or law enforcement

## BSED

---

Of the 80 responses, three have not started classes yet. Therefore calculations reflect 77 responses.

Q1. 90% reported that Doral College instructors taught “very well” or “extremely well”.

Q2. 86% reported that instructors frequently responded to email within 48 hours.

Q3. The question was not administered to this demographic as it only applies to Dual Enrollment students.

Q4. 94% of the respondents stated that their course / program goals were achieved.

Q5. 95% reported satisfaction with the admissions process and 85% reported satisfaction with the registration process. As these two processes are the first interactions a student has with the College, the percentages are positive.

Q6. 98% reported satisfaction with the use of Canvas, 97% reported satisfaction with the Helpfulness of the webpage, 97% reported satisfaction with the help desks, 95% reported satisfaction with the learning resources. Overall, this demographic of students is highly satisfied with the resources Doral College has put into place to foster student success.

Q7. 97% reported satisfaction with their studies. Once again, the high percentage is one metric to demonstrate Doral College’s mission of “...delivering dynamic educational experiences by blending traditional and online learning, supportive partnerships, and technology to empower highly motivated and dedicated students to overcome conventional barriers.”

Q8. 99% would recommend Doral College studies to a friend

Q9. The purpose of this question is to determine what specific barriers are in place for this demographic. 17% reported they were challenged by the difficulty of the material, 66% reported they were challenged by lack of time or too many responsibilities, 10% reported they were challenged by lack of wi-fi / computer access.

Q10. 26% reported at least one parent earned a four year degree. This data can be used by Doral College to create tools and programs to successfully guide students through the process of completing their program.

Q11. 13% reported interest in a BBA program.

Q12. 10% reported interest in a BAS concentrating in legal studies, criminal justice, or law enforcement

- Q1: Of the responses 66 % of students indicated Doral College instructors teach extremely or very well.
- Q2: 59% of students indicated their College instructors frequently responded to email within 48 hours. It is important to note that 27 % indicated they have never tried to contact an instructor via email.
- Q3: This multi-part question addressed satisfaction with the variety and number of online and hybrid courses.
  - Variety of face to face hybrid courses 86% responded very satisfied or satisfied.
  - Number of face to face hybrid courses 85% responded very satisfied or satisfied.
  - Variety of online courses offered, 93% responded very satisfied or satisfied.
  - Number of online courses offered 93% responded very satisfied or satisfied,
- Q4: 81% of students indicated they achieved, or will have achieved upon completing their studies, the goals they had when they started the course or program.
- Q5: The majority of students indicated satisfaction with the services provided by the Office of Admissions & Student Services with 94% indicating they have satisfaction with the admission process and 93% indicating satisfaction with the registration process.
- Q6: This multi-part question addressed satisfaction with the College's LMS, web page, help desks, and learning resources. 95% of students indicated they were either very satisfied or satisfied with the use of Canvas. Regarding the web page, 91% responded they were either very satisfied or satisfied. 90 % of the students responded they were either very satisfied or satisfied with the help desks. Regarding learning resources 89% indicated satisfaction.
- Q7: 85% of students indicated they were satisfied with their studies with the College.
- Q8: 83% of students indicated they would recommend the College to a friend.
- Q9: Students indicated a number of factors that affected their ability to complete their College coursework. For example, 57% said lack of time/too many responsibilities were a factor, 26% indicated the material was too difficult, while 17%% said lack of computers/Wi-Fi was a factor.
- Q10: More than half of students (59%) indicated that at least one parent had attained a four-year degree.
- Q11: Regarding participating in free or reduced lunch at their home high school, more than half (57%) of the students responded yes.
- Q12: 44% are interested in a BBA program.
- Q13: 35% are interested in a BAS program concentrating in legal studies, criminal justice, or law enforcement

- Q14: This open ended question asked what other degrees or interests the students had. These responses are included in Appendix 1.
- Q15: This open ended question asked for additional feedback. The majority of the responses were very positive. All responses are included in Appendix 2

## Non-Degree Lower Level

---

The results reported below are from the 43 responses. Of those 43 responses, one respondent had not started classes yet. Therefore, the percentages are calculated based on 42 responses.

- Q1: Of the responses 80% of students indicated Doral College instructors teach extremely or very well.
- Q2: 77% of students indicated their College instructors frequently responded to email within 48 hours.
- Q3: This multi-part question addressed satisfaction with the variety and number of online and hybrid courses. This question was not provided to non degree lower level students.
- Q4: 88% of students indicated they achieved, or will have achieved upon completing their studies, the goals they had when they started the course or program.
- Q5: The majority of students indicated satisfaction with the services provided by the Office of Admissions & Student Services with 97% indicating they have satisfaction with the admission process and 95% indicating satisfaction with the registration process.
- Q6: This multi-part question addressed satisfaction with the College's LMS, web page, help desks, and learning resources. 93% of students indicated they were either very satisfied or satisfied with the use of Canvas. Regarding the web page, 90% responded they were either very satisfied or satisfied. Just as with the web page, 93% of the students responded they were either very satisfied or satisfied with the help desks. Regarding learning resources only 94% indicated satisfaction.
- Q7: 90% of students indicated they were satisfied with their studies with the College, indicating an extremely high level of overall student satisfaction.
- Q8: 89% of students indicated they would recommend the College to a friend.
- Q9: Students indicated a number of factors that affected their ability to complete their College coursework. For example, 86% said lack of time/too many responsibilities were a factor, 11% indicated the material was too difficult, while 11% said lack of computers/Wi-Fi was a factor.
- Q10: Fewer than half of students (48%) indicated that at least one parent had attained a four-year degree.

- Q11: The question regarding participating in free or reduced lunch at their home high school was not administered to this group.
- Q12: 12% are interested in a BBA.
- Q13: 12% are interested in a BAS program concentrating in legal studies, criminal justice, or law enforcement.

## Non-Degree Upper Level

---

The results reported below are from the 82 responses. Of those 82 responses, 1 respondent had not started classes yet. Therefore, the percentages are calculated based on 81 responses.

- Q1: Of the responses 90% of students indicated Doral College instructors teach extremely or very well.
- Q2: 95% of students indicated their College instructors frequently responded to email within 48 hours.
- Q3: This multi-part question addressed satisfaction with the variety and number of online and hybrid courses. This question was not provided to this group.
- Q4: 98% of students indicated they achieved, or will have achieved upon completing their studies, the goals they had when they started the course or program.

- Q5: The majority of students indicated satisfaction with the services provided by the Office of Admissions & Student Services with 86% indicating they have satisfaction with the admission process and 97% indicating satisfaction with the registration process.
- Q6: This multi-part question addressed satisfaction with the College's LMS, web page, help desks, and learning resources. 96% of students indicated they were either very satisfied or satisfied with the use of Canvas. Regarding the web page, 94% responded they were either very satisfied or satisfied. 95% of the students responded they were either very satisfied or satisfied with the help desks. Regarding learning resources, only 93% indicated satisfaction.
- Q7: 98% of students indicated they were satisfied with their studies with the College, indicating an extremely high level of overall student satisfaction.
- Q8: 96% of students indicated they would recommend the College to a friend.
- Q9: Students indicated a number of factors that affected their ability to complete their College coursework. For example, 69% said lack of time/too many responsibilities were a factor, 7% indicated the material was too difficult, while 4% said lack of computers/Wi-Fi was a factor.
- Q10: Fewer than half of students (48%) indicated that at least one parent had attained a four-year degree.
- Q11: The question regarding participating in free or reduced lunch at their home high school was not administered to this group.
- Q12: 6% indicated interest in a BBA program
- Q13: 5% indicated interest in a BAS program concentrating in legal studies, criminal justice, or law enforcement

## Data Comparison

---

Survey results were, on the whole, very positive and provided insight into the student population. This school year was the second time the report segregated students by demographic. During analysis, it was noted overall students indicated a high level of support and awareness regarding most aspects of the College. Of the respondents, the majority were dual enrolled 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> graders. The following is a question-by-question analysis of the results by demographic:

Q1. How well do your Doral College instructors teach? The percentages below detail a demographic background for answering extremely well or very well.

## Analysis

---

The data is first analyzed internally by the President, Vice President for Student Affairs, Vice President for Academic Affairs, and the Director of Institutional Effectiveness. Next, the three parties meet to discuss the data and implications for overall future plans. Next the data is shared with a larger group of stakeholders during the strategic planning meeting to solicit more insight and determine how the data aligns with current institutional goals. Finally, the suggestions are added to the strategic plan as goals or action items.

Overall, the results are positive and reflect that Doral College’s mission of “...delivering dynamic educational experiences by blending traditional and online learning, supportive partnerships,

and technology to empower highly motivated and dedicated students to overcome conventional barriers.” is being met.

## Use of Results

---

Overall, this year’s results are overwhelmingly positive and indicate the majority of students experience a high level of satisfaction with the College as a whole. There are a few areas in which results merit action. The College will do the following to address these issues:
