


## AP classes in the $\mathbf{1 2}^{\text {th }}$ grade: Please note a max of 9 credits are awarded from AP classes taken in the $12^{\text {th }}$ grade.

Core courses as general electives: Once a core area has been satisfied for graduation then any additional credits in that area will be applied to your general elective requirements. For example, you only need 3 credits of Humanities, so if you pass both AP Art History and AP Music Theory 3 credits will be applied to your Humanities requirement and the other 3 credits will be applied towards your GE requirement. Another example, if you complete College Algebra and Liberal Arts math but later pass AP Calculus your AP Calculus credits will be applied towards your general electives.
