

BSED FTCE EXAM TIMELINE

01

After completing 45 credits & ideally before you begin the BSED program:

-Study for and take the FTCE General Knowledge Test (GK).

This exam includes subtests in reading, writing, and mathematic skills. You also will need to write an essay.



02

After completing 75 credits:

-Study for and take the FTCE Professional Education Test (PEd).

This exam evaluates your understanding of teaching practices, classroom management, and professional responsibilities.

03

After completing 90 credits or sooner:

-Study and take the FTCE Subject Area K-6 Examination.

-The FTCE subject area K-6 exam consists of four subtests that cover knowledge in four separate subject areas:

Subtest 1: Language Arts and Reading

Subtest 2: Social Science

Subtest 3: Science

Subtest 4: Mathematics



04

***After completing 114 credits:**

-Study and take any outstanding exams.

Students must pass all required FTCE exams listed above before enrolling in EDF 4943 – Student Teaching Internship. Not passing FTCE exams prior to Student Teaching may affect your projected academic track and may delay completion of the BSED program and degree conferral.
