



DORAL PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP

Provides full tuition to high school graduates seeking to enroll in one of the College's undergraduate degree programs, which include the Associate in Arts, the Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education (BSED) and Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA).

Eligibility Criteria

To qualify, students must:

- Be a graduate of the high school class of 2024;
- Have a cumulative high school GPA of at least a 2.0;
- Demonstrate financial need;
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or other individual familiar with the student and their academic goals, (preferred);
- Complete the College's Scholarship application; and
- Be admitted to Doral College and register for a minimum of 12 credits in the fall and spring terms as a degree-seeking student.

Preference will be given to:

- Students enrolling in a bachelor's degree program;
- Students who have previously enrolled in Doral College dual enrollment courses; and/or
- Graduates of Doral College dual enrollment partner schools.

Please Note: United States citizenship, residency, or legal status is not required.

Duration & Renewal

The Doral Promise Scholarship covers full tuition for the student's chosen degree program as follows:

- For the Associate in Arts, a maximum of 60 credits will be covered.
- For the Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education (BSED), a maximum of 123 credits will be covered.
- For the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA), a maximum of 120 credits will be covered.

Scholarship funds may be used during the summer terms. Students may not exceed the maximum allowable credits for their chosen program.

The scholarship is automatically renewable as long as the student remains enrolled full time in the chosen degree program and maintains Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) as per the College's published policy.
