Graduate Transfer Report—Class of 2023

Description: The following report serves to provide information regarding the post-graduation plans of Doral College's tenth graduating class.

Collection: This information was submitted via an electronic form by the graduates as part of the application for graduation and overall exit process.

Summary of Data:

There were 329 graduates in Doral College's tenth graduating class. 75% of graduates reported receiving at least one scholarship, and 99% went on to continue their education at a four-year post-secondary institution, as follows:
