



MAESTRO CARES SCHOLARSHIP

Provides full tuition for one year to high school graduates seeking to enroll in one of the College's undergraduate degree programs. The vision of the Maestro Cares Foundation Scholarship Program is to support individuals with significant financial need, who despite personal or social setbacks, have a compelling desire to pursue a higher education

Eligibility Criteria

To qualify, students must:

- Be a high school graduate of the Class of 2024;
- Demonstrate financial need;
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5 GPA;
- Have an interest in service and commit to volunteering a minimum of twenty (20) hours of community service during the academic year;
- Be of Latin or Hispanic decent;
- Complete the College's Scholarship application; and
- Be admitted to Doral College and register for a minimum of 12 credits in the fall and spring terms as a degree-seeking student.

Preference will be given to:

- Students enrolling in a bachelor's degree program; and
- Graduates of Doral College dual enrollment partner schools.

Please Note: United States citizenship, residency, or legal status is not required.

Duration & Renewal

Currently, the Maestro Cares Scholarship is not renewable to a second year. Should additional funds become available, scholarship recipients will be notified. In addition, Maestro Cares Scholarship recipients will be considered for other available forms of financial aid, including the Doral Promise Scholarship, to ensure they have the option to complete their degrees with Doral College.

Scholarship funds may be used during the summer terms. Scholarship recipients must maintain a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average (GPA) during the academic year.
