

## HOW TO NAVIGATE YOUR MAESTRO PLAN OF STUDY

## **HOW TO ACCESS IT:**

Login to Maestro
Click on the tab on the left titled "Academic Info"
Then click on "plan of study"

## HOW TO INTERPRET IT:

Your Plan of Study lists the different "Study Groups" you must fulfill to earn your AA

You will see 3 columns:

"Required"
Credits

"Earned" Credits "Remaining" Credits

Each study group is broken up into **State Core** and **DC Core**, with the exception of English and General Electives. Clicking on the title of the study group will bring up a list of courses for that group. The courses you have completed with Doral are highlighted in green, while those completed through transfer are purple. "Active" courses, ones you are currently enrolled in, will appear as either light green or red, depending on whether you are on pace in the course. Remember that if you are currently enrolled in a course, the credits will not be applied to the study group until the semester is complete the and the credits are earned

You must earn 6 credits in each general area to earn your degree, except in the General Electives Study Group, which requires 24 credits

In the **English** study group, you must earn 6 credits. No distinction between DC or State Core is made in this study group

In the **Math** study group, you can either earn 6 credits in the State Core category **or** 3 credits in State Core and 3 Credits in DC Core\*

In the **Science** study group, you can either earn 6 credits in the State Core category <u>or</u> 3 credits in DC Core\*

In the **History** study group, you can either earn 6 credits in the State Core category <u>or</u> 3 credits in State Core and 3 Credits in DC Core\*

In the **Social Science** study group, you can either earn 6 credits in the State Core category <u>or</u> 3 credits in State Core and 3 Credits in DC Core\*

In the **Humanities** study group, you can either earn 6 credits in the State Core category <u>or</u> 3 credits in State Core and 3 Credits in DC Core\*
